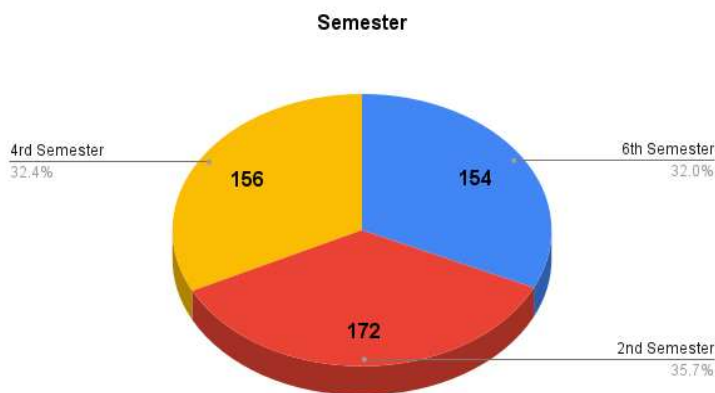

**STAKEHOLDERS FEEDBACK REPORT**

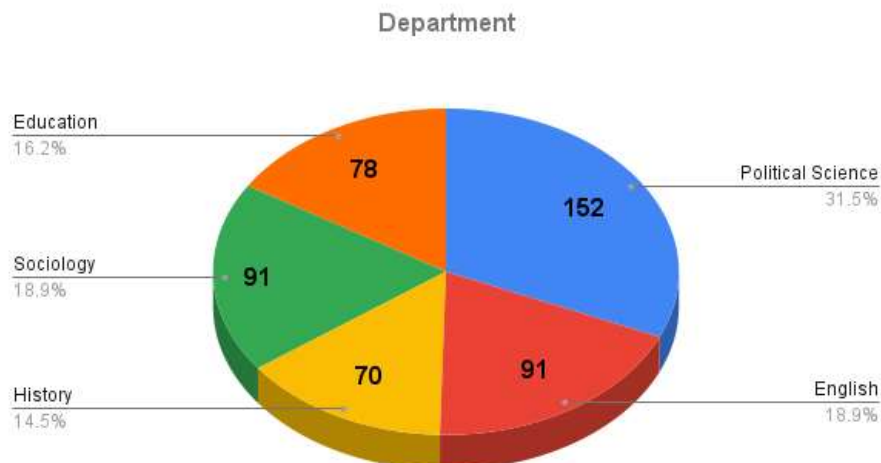
Collecting Feedback from the stakeholders is very important for the success of the institution. The feedback is collected using Likert scale where there are five points: Excellent, Very Good, Good, Average and Poor.

**STUDENTS FEEDBACK ON CURRICULUM**

The Students plays a central role in the internal and external quality assurance and their feedback is very important for the institution. The feedback for 2020-21 is collected through online. Total 481 student responded in the feedback on the curriculum. The feedback is collected from the even semester students. 172 students from 2<sup>nd</sup> Semester, 156 students from 4<sup>rd</sup> Semester and 154 students from 6<sup>th</sup> Semester.

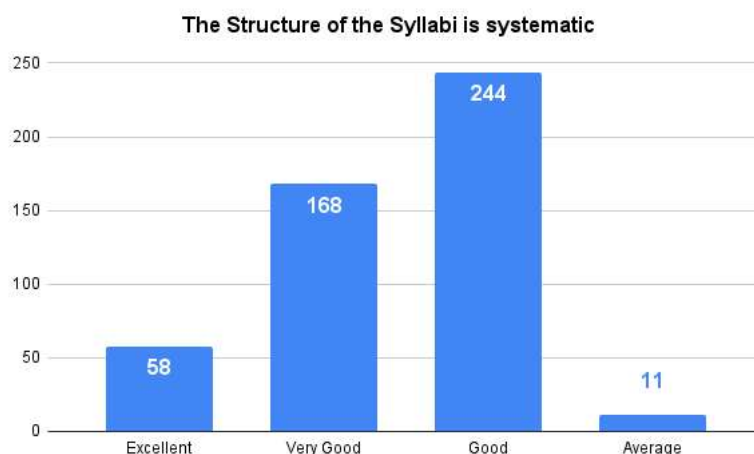


The college have five department and the feedback is collected from the students of all the department. 100% feedback was collected.

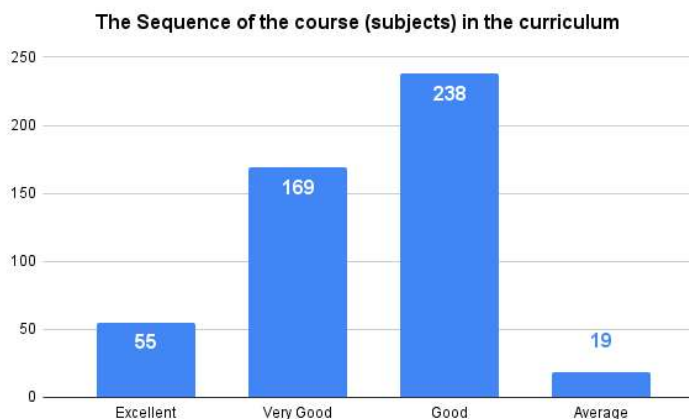

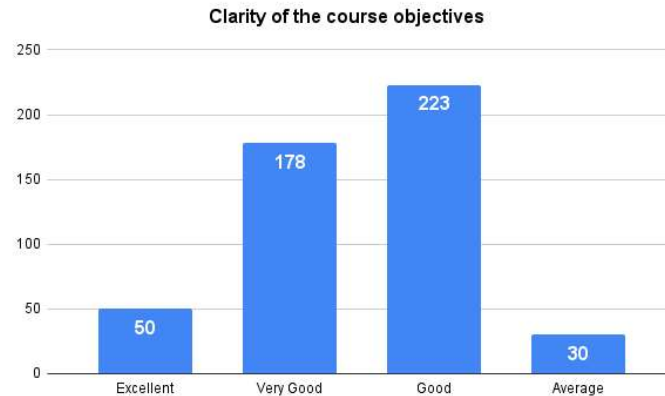
The Feedback collected is compiled and put into graph to analyze each points.



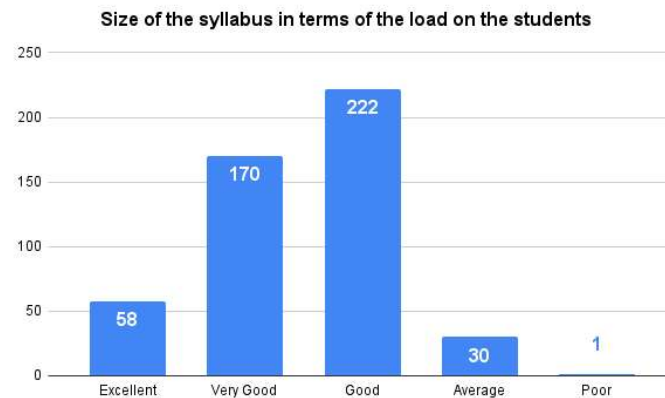
Out of 481 students, 244 students responded that the structure of the syllabi is systematic, whereas 11 students responded that the structure of the syllabi is average.



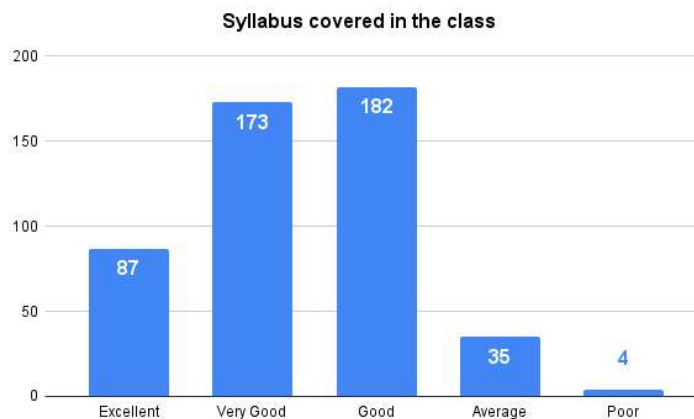
Majority of the students are satisfied with the sequence of the course (subjects) in the curriculum, 55 students mentioned that the sequence of the course is excellent whereas 19 students responded by mentioning that it is average.



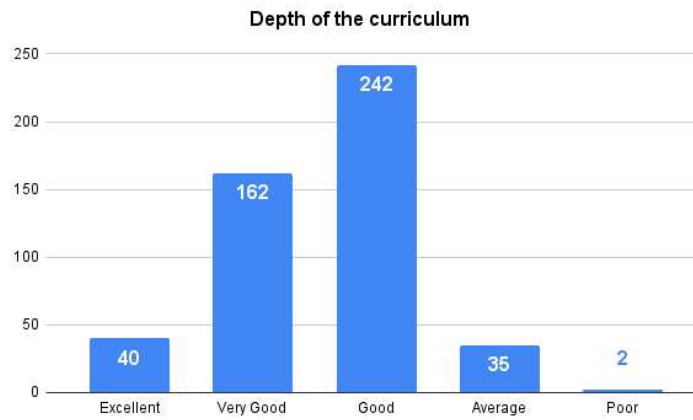
The Clarity of the course objectives was good for 223 students and 178 students mentioned that it is very good, out of 481 students responded, 50 students said that it is excellent.



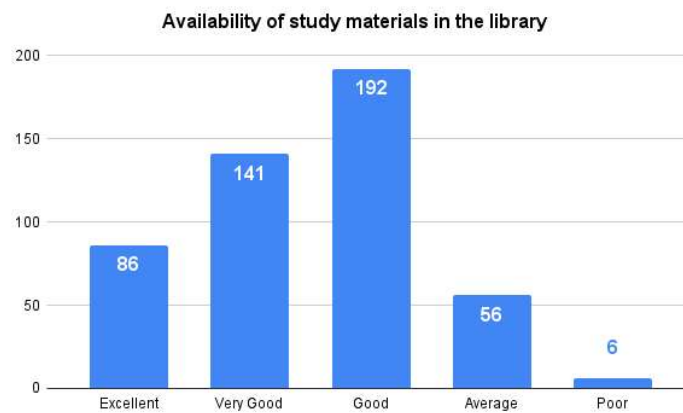
Out of 481 students, 58 students responded that the size of the syllabus in terms of the load of the students is excellent, and most of the students are of the opinion that it is good, whereas 1 students mentioned that it is poor.



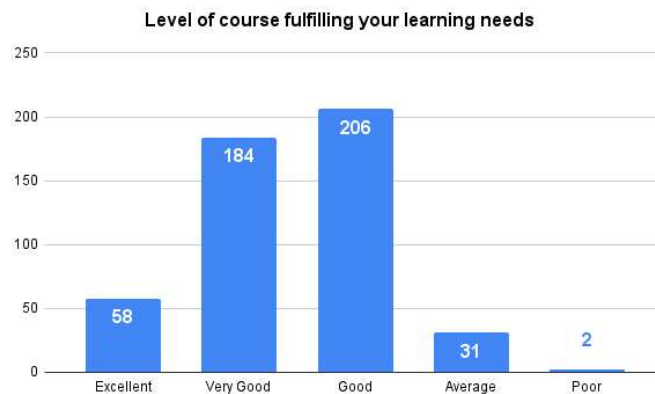
More than 85% of the students responded that the syllabus covered in the class is excellent, very good and good but around 15% of the students responded that it and average and poor



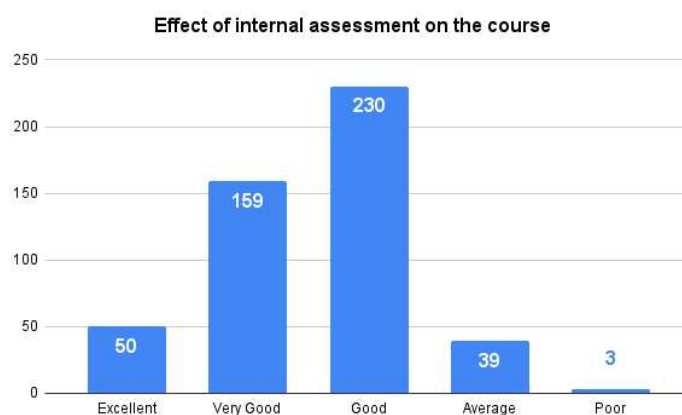
The depth of the curriculum is good and very good for majority of the students, 40 students mentioned that it is excellent but 2 students were of the opinion that it is poor.



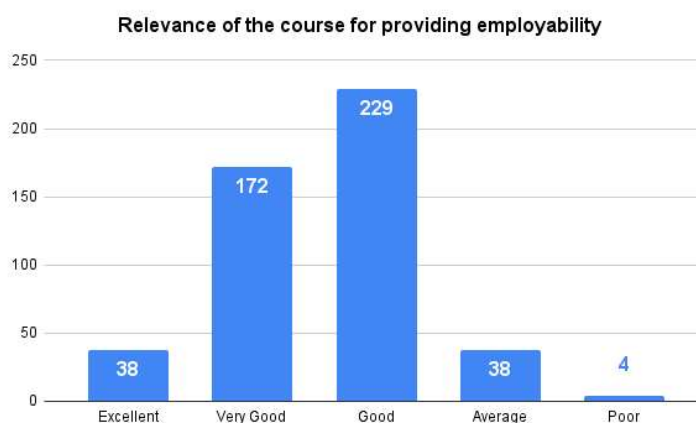
The availability of study materials in the library is excellent for 86 students, and 141 and 192 students responded that it is very good and good respectively. 56 students feel that it is average but 6 students mentioned that it is poor.



More than 75% of the students responded that the level of course fulfil their learning needs, 58 students mentioned that the level of course fulfilling their learning needs is excellent whereas 2 students responded that it is poor.



Out of 481 students, 230 students mentioned that the effect of internal assessment on the course is good, 159 students responded that it is very good and 50 students responded that it is excellent whereas 3 students feel that it is poor.



The relevance of the course for providing employability is very good and good for majority of the students, for some students it is excellent whereas 4 students said it is poor.

### **Overall Feedback Analysis**

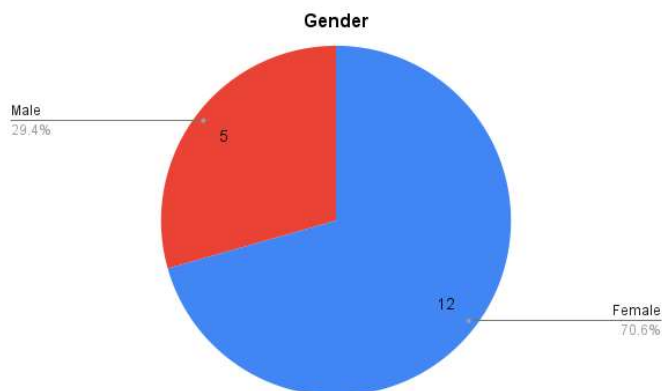
More than 85% of the students are showing positive response on the current curriculum, around 10% of the students feel that the curriculum is average and 5% of the students mentioned that the syllabus covered in the class, depth of the curriculum, availability of study materials in the library, level of course fulfilling the learning needs, effect of internal assessment on the course and relevance of the course for providing employability is poor.

The institution strive to meet the requirement of the students so the 5% students opinion will be taken into account and will work to reach their expectation by taking necessary action.

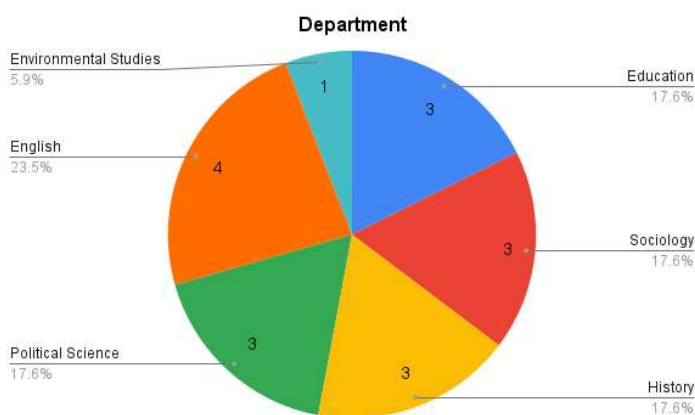
## TEACHERS FEEDBACK ON CURRICULUM

Teachers being the most important person in curriculum delivery, implementation, and feedback on the curriculum by teachers are the utmost importance. The college is affiliated to Nagaland University and followed a prescribed curriculum but the institution collected online feedback from the teachers regarding improvement in the syllabus. There are 17 teaching faculty in the institution and so the feedback was collected from all the staff.

Out of the 17 teaching staff, there are 12 female and 5 male staff



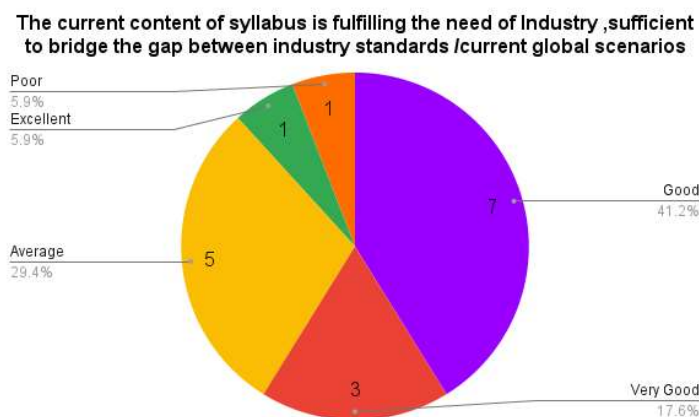
The institution has five department and Environmental studies, where the staff from all the department has responded.



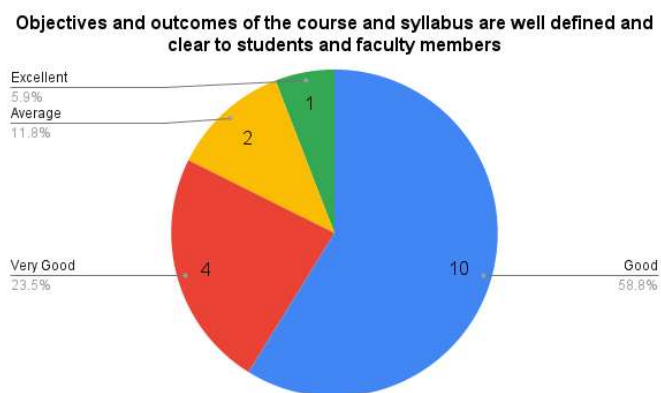

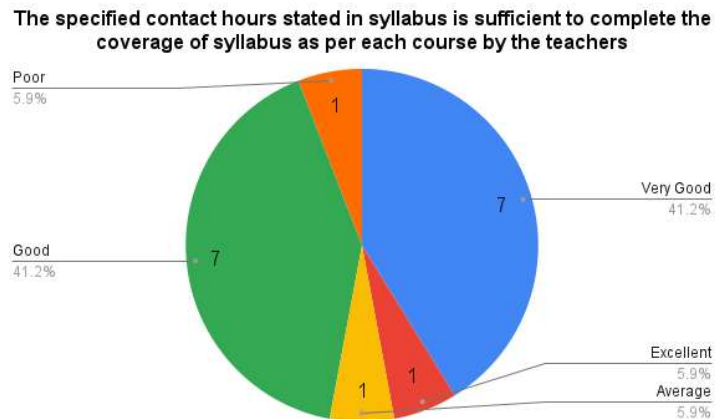
The feedback collected is compiled and are analyzed using pie chart for each question and is represented below.



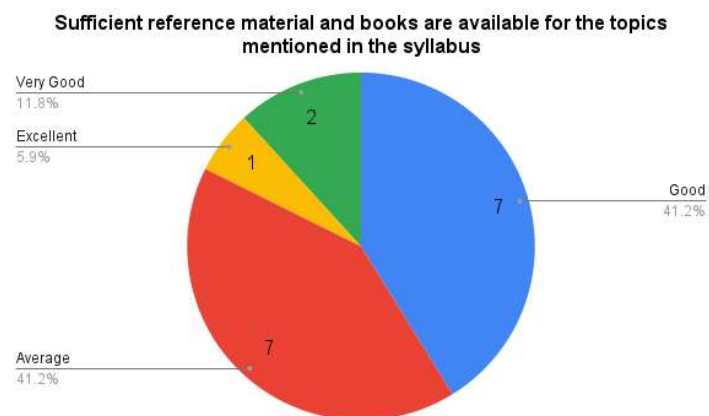

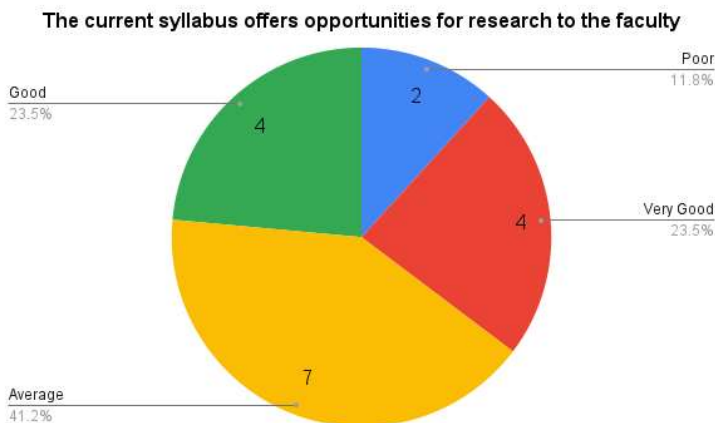
More than 70% of staff responded that the objectives and outcomes of the course and syllabus are well defined and clear to students and faculty mentioned. No staff have mentioned it is poor. 1 staff responded that it is excellent and 2 staff responded that it is average.



Out of 17 staff, 14 staff responded that the specified contact hours stated in syllabus is sufficient to complete the coverage of syllabus as per each course, 2 staff mentioned that it is excellent and average whereas 1 staff responded that the specified hours stated in the syllabus is poor.

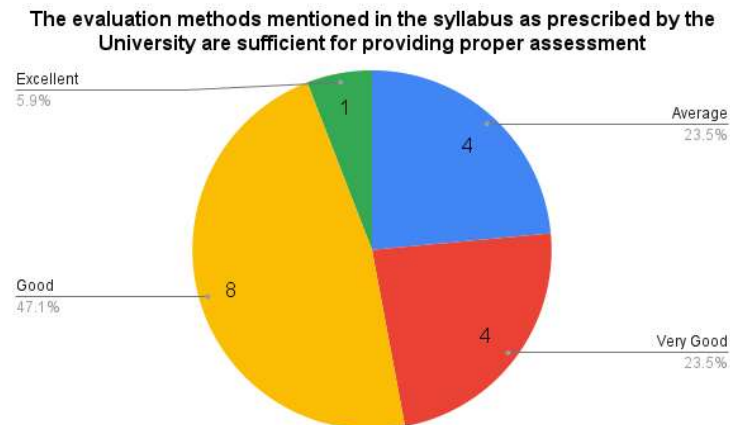

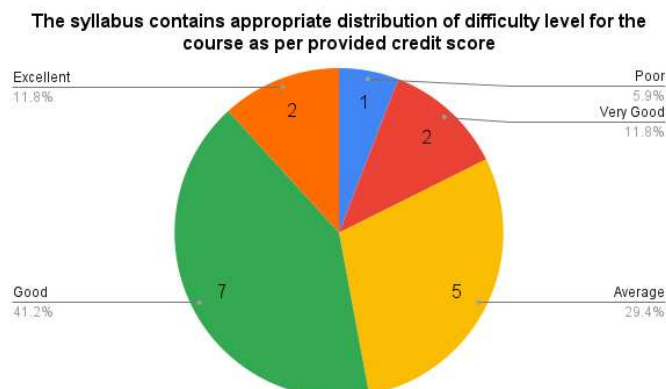
Out of 100%, 70% of the staff responded that the evaluation methods mentioned in the syllabus as prescribed by the University are sufficient for providing proper assessment is very good and good, no staff has mentioned that it is poor, 23.5% staff mentioned that it is average whereas 5.9% staff were of the opinion that it is excellent.



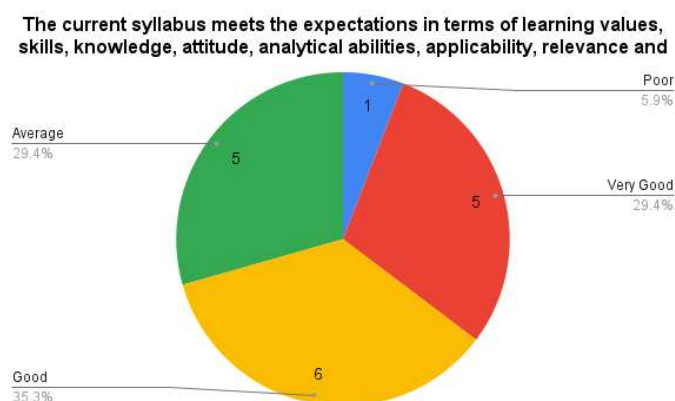
The provision of updating the course/ syllabus by the university is very good and good for 11 staff, and for 5 staff it is average whereas 1 staff mentioned that it is poor.

The current syllabus meets the expectations in terms of learning values, skills, knowledge, attitude, analytical abilities, applicability, relevance and practical orientation to real life situations is good for 6 staff, 5 staff responded that it is very good and another 5 staff responded that it is average. 1 staff responded that it is poor.

### Overall Feedback Analysis

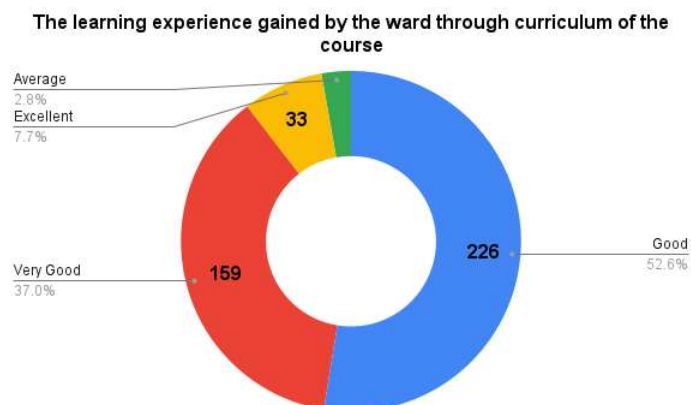
Most of the staff have rated the current curriculum to be excellent, very good and good whereas there are few areas where the curriculum requires improvement as mentioned by the staff, improvement in areas like syllabus fulfilling the need of industry, Industry ,sufficient to bridge the gap between industry standards /current global scenarios and academics, reducing the vastness of the syllabus for some course inorder to equipped the students in the best possible way, providing research opportunities, updation of the syllabus, creating syllabus to provide employment opportunities for students, syllabus to meet the expectations in terms of learning values, skills, knowledge, attitude, analytical abilities, applicability, relevance and practical orientation to real life situations.

## PARENTS FEEDBACK ON CURRICULUM

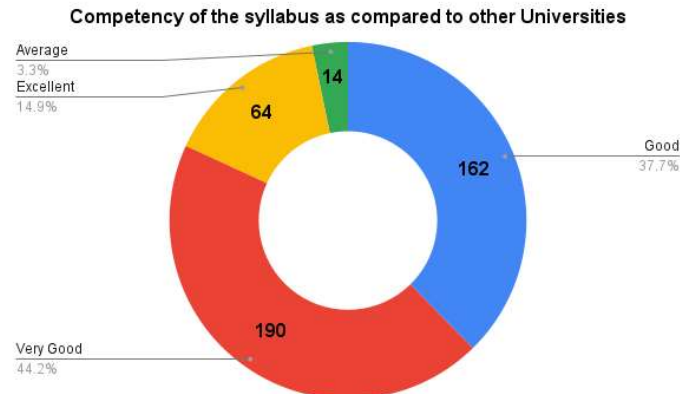

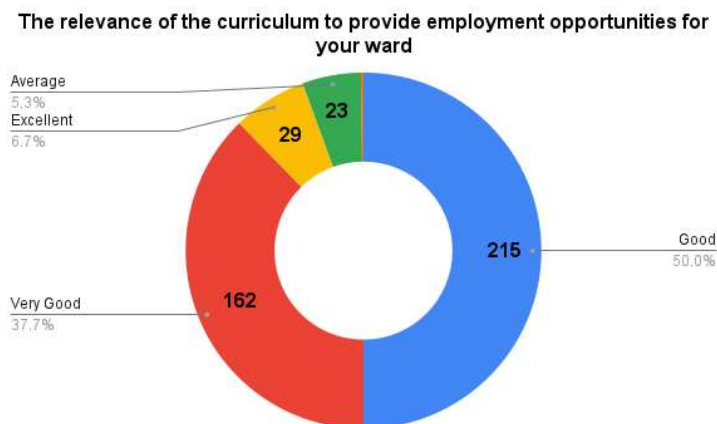
The feedback collected is compiled and are analyzed using pie chart for each question and is represented below.



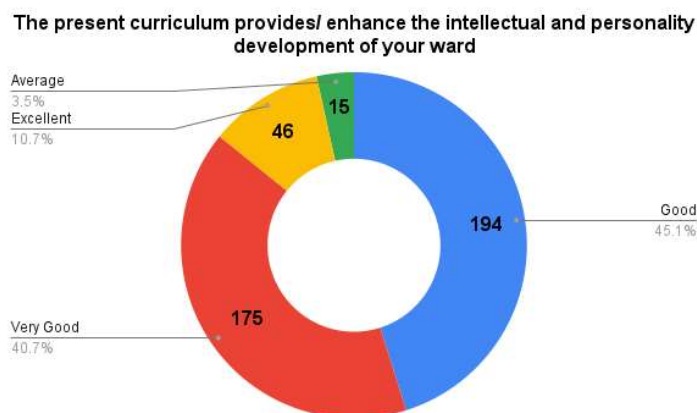

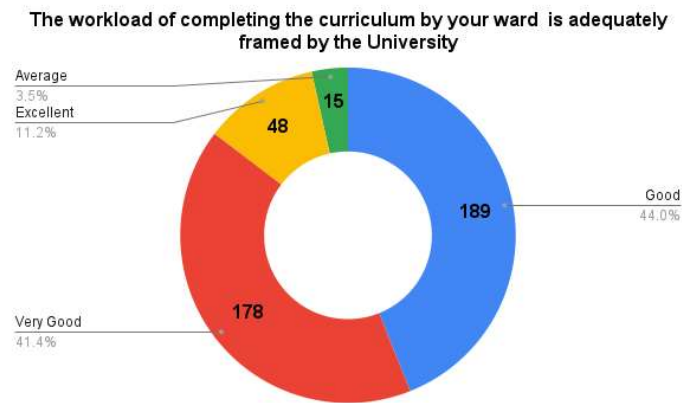

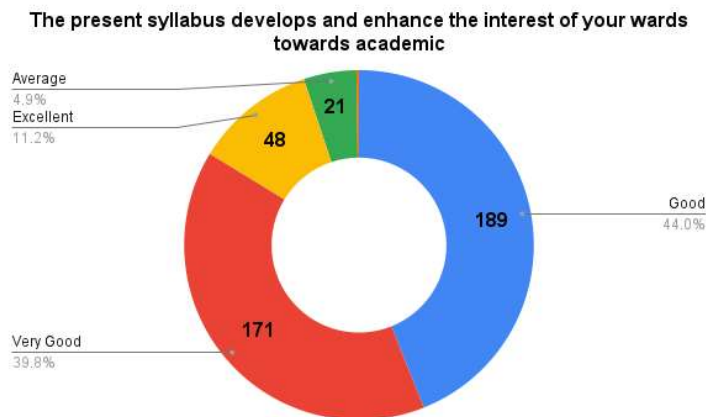

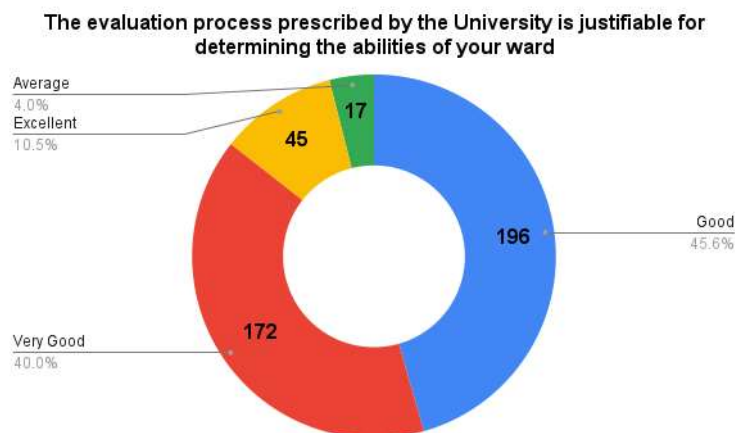
Out of 100% respondent, more than 80% parents responded that the present curriculum enhance the intellectual and personality development of their ward, 10.7% responded that it is excellent.

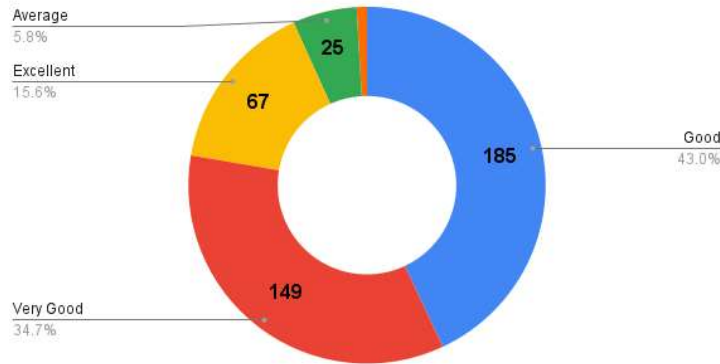

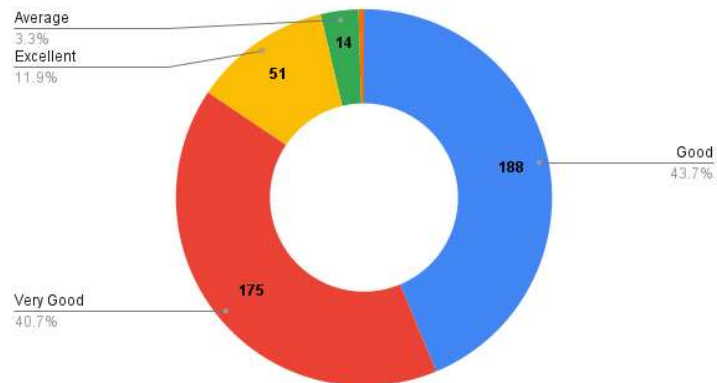

**The availability of learning materials and latest technology in the market to support the current curriculum**



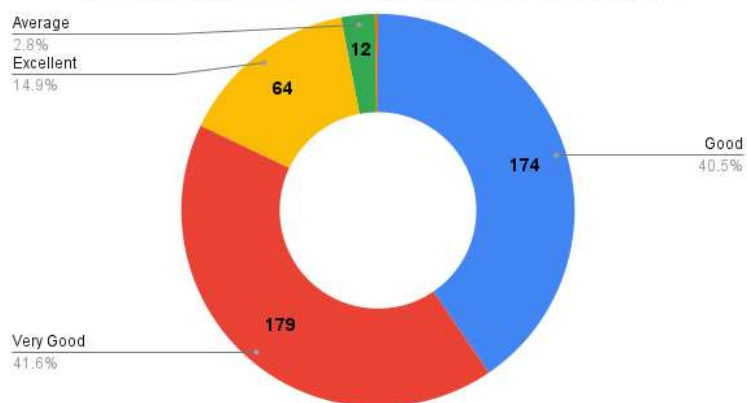

## Overall Feedback Analysis

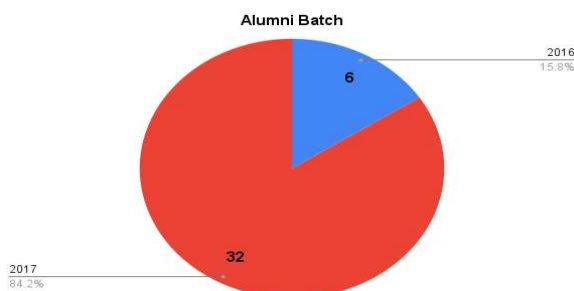
Most of the parents are satisfied with the present curriculum, it is observed that the curriculum is benefitted to majority of the students in the most efficient way, most of the parents are of the opinion that their ward is gaining maximum knowledge and it is also helping in the personality development of the students, the parents are also of the opinion that their ward with the present curriculum is helping them for their career, providing them opportunities for their higher studies in a much better way. ## ALUMNI FEEDBACK ON CURRICULUM

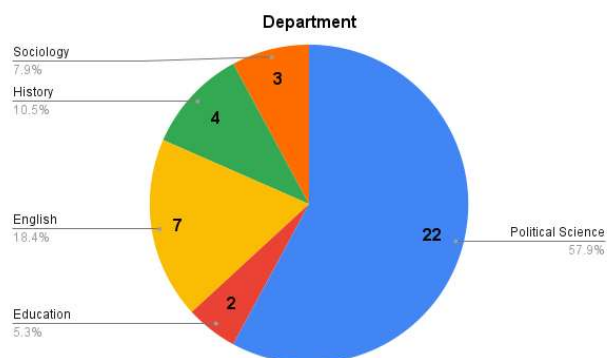

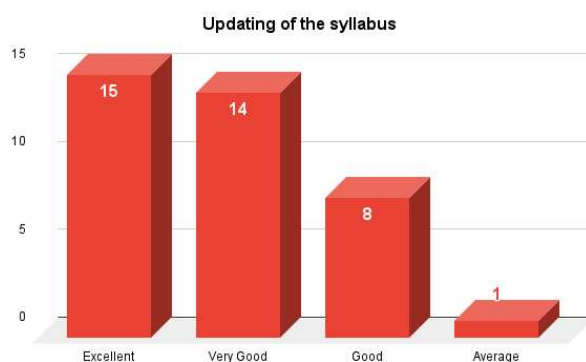

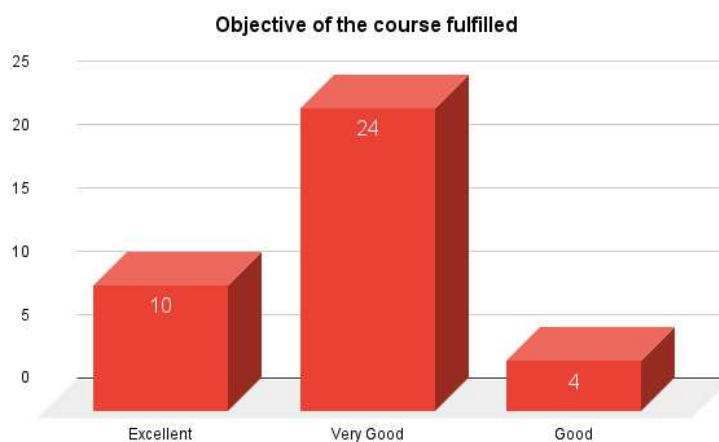
From the 2016 batch, 6 Alumni responded and from 2017 batch 2017 Alumni responded.



The College has five departments, where the feedback was collected from each department, so that no department is left out for the feedback on curriculum. The College has majority of students from the Political Science Department, where in the feedback, 57.9% of the Political Science Alumni gave their feedback.

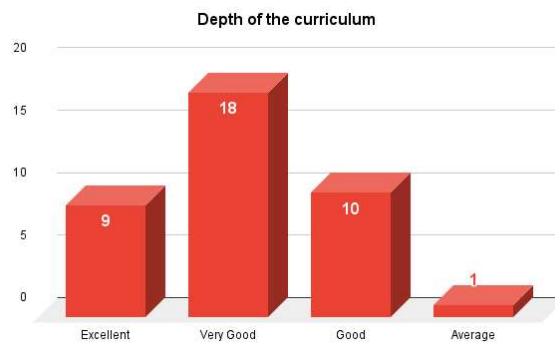

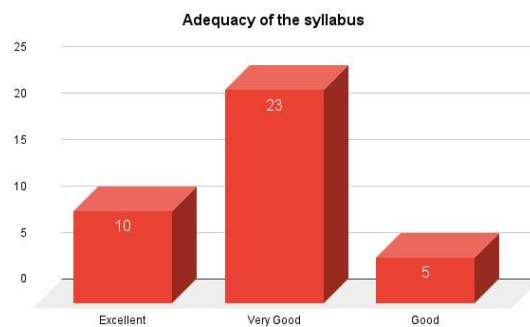

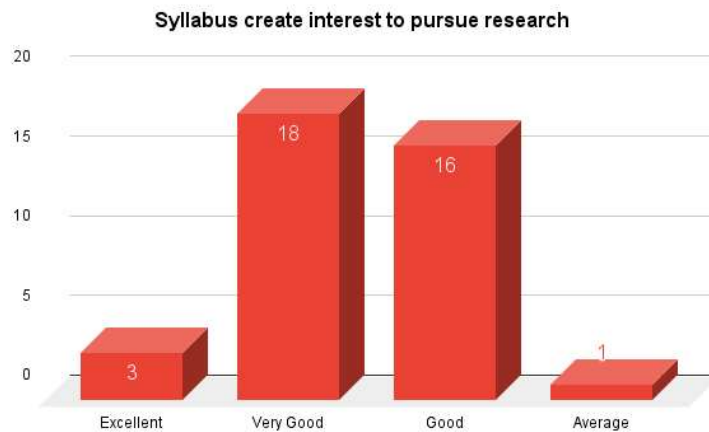
More than 50% of the Alumni responded that adequacy of the syllabus is very good, where 10 mentioned it is excellent and 5 said it is good.



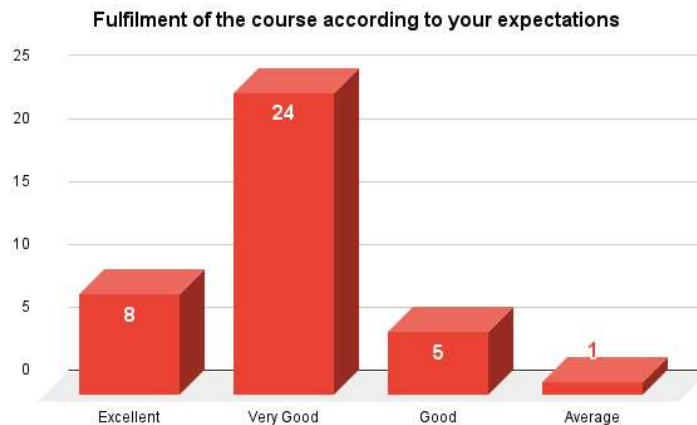

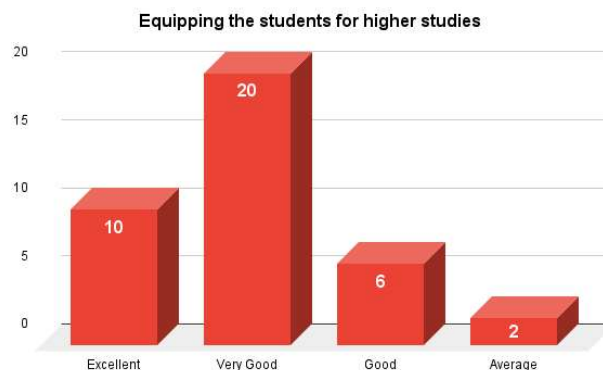
The institute uses different methods of giving assignment to the students where the students will be trained in all aspects such as Writing and Speaking. The Assignment strategies employed was very good for 20 Alumni, 8 Alumni mentioned it is excellent and another 8 responded it is good. Only 2 responded that it is average.



Out of 38 respondent, 18 and 16 Alumni responded that the syllabus creates interest to pursue research is very good and good respectively. 3 Alumni responded it is excellent and 1 Alumni mentioned it is average.



Out of 100%, more than 60% mentioned that the course is fulfilled according to their expectations, 8 Alumni responded it is excellent and 1 Alumni is of the opinion that it is average.



Majority of the Alumni are found to pursue their higher studies, where 20 Alumni responded that the curriculum equipping the students is very good, 10 Alumni mentioned it is excellent and the rest responded that it is good and average.



Out of 38 Alumni who responded, 16 Alumni and 10 Alumni responded that the course in terms of employability skills is very good and excellent respectively. 9 Alumni are of the opinion that it is good, 2 Alumni responded it is average and 1 mentioned it is poor.

### **Overall Feedback Analysis**

Alumni responses help the institution to improve and grow. As seen in the table and analyze, most of the Alumni are satisfied with the curriculum that is provided. Some of the Alumni mentioned that updating of the syllabus, objective of the course fulfilled, adequacy of the syllabus, easy availability of the course material, equipping the students for higher studies and course in terms of employability skills is excellent. And majority of the Alumni mentioned that the updating of the syllabus, objectives of the course fulfilled, adequacy of the syllabus, assignment strategies employed, fulfilment of the course according to their expectations, creating interest for higher studies and course content for employment is very good and good. Whereas there are some few students who mentioned that updating of the syllabus, depth of the curriculum, assignment strategies employed, fulfillment of the course as per their expectations, the interest to pursue research, for higher studies and the employability skills is average, and there is only one student who stated that the curriculum in terms of employability skill is very poor.
